

#### The report balanced goals to:


- Strengthen student enrolment

- On August 2, 2019, Premier McNeil announced that Marconi Campus will move to the Esplanade, between Falmouth Street and Byng Avenue (approx.)
- The Province is finalizing some of the purchases of the over 30 parcels of land
- The Province also announced that the College will issue RFPs for architectural design, construction management and remediation.
- The total for the Phase I portion of the project is estimated at over \$18 million.

- March 2020: Finalize design
- April 2020: RFP trade packages
- May 2020: Construction begins
- September 2024: Campus is scheduled to open
